

GENDER PAY GAP REPORT 2024


Under legislation that came into force in April 2017, UK employers with more than 250 employees are required to publish their gender pay gap. Aspire Multi-Academy Trust is required to report its gender pay gap data for the organisation as a whole.

PAY DATA

PAY QUANTILES

The image across shows the gender distribution at Aspire Multi-Academy Trust when colleagues are placed into four equally sized quartiles based on pay.



Aspire Multi-Academy Trust does not make bonus payments to employees and is therefore unable to report on:

- Mean bonus gender pay gap
- Median bonus gender pay gap
- The proportion of males receiving a bonus payment
- The proportion of females receiving a bonus payment
